- 2 Previous Meeting Minutes
 - 2.1 Motion to approve previous meeting minutes by Brandon Johnson, 2nd by Jonathon Westphal
- 3 Financial Report
 - 3.1 No Financial Report Given
- 4 Principal's Report given by Julie Quamme
 - 4.1 Enrollment
 - 4.1.1 Current enrollment for this year is at 210.
 - 4.1.2 Next year's enrollment is sitting at 206 with 3 students still in progress. There are still 22 students who have not finished the process with maybe a potential of 6 or 7 of these students not returning.
 - 4.1.3 Biggest enrollments for next year seem to be coming for Preschool through 2nd grade.
 - 4.1.4 Yesterday we had 3 calls alone of families wanting to move over.
 - 4.2 Vision Committee
 - 4.2.1 Biggest take away was does the current plan that has been proposed have enough space for what is needed. And there is a huge need in our community for this at this time.

- 4.2.2 Talked about the possible need for a paid Fundraising "director." That could really manage the fundraisers, keep track of the money, maybe only part-time at first.

- 4.3 Fundraisers
 - 4.3.1 This is the highest amount that we have ever made selling chocolate! The total was around \$18,000! About \$1,500 will come out of this for prizes the rest is profit!
 - 4.3.2 Move-a-thon has been moved to May 12th. The funds will be used to get the technology updated.
- 4.4 Teacher Interviews
 - 4.4.1 An offer has been made and excepted to a 5th grade teacher.
 - 4.4.2 A second interview is happening with a Minot State student.
 - 4.4.3 There is also a staff member who will be eligible to be hired.

- 7 Pastors Report given by Father Kovash
 - 7.1 Early Childhood Center
 - 7.1.1 Father has been on the phone a lot with JE Dunn and our architect.
 - 7.1.2 Prices of materials have really been going up. The price has went from an original plan of 3 million to over 4 million dollars.
 - 7.1.3 Right now, 3.46 million dollars has been committed and 2.6 million is in the bank.
 - 7.1.4 Brick is now cheaper, so the plan is to go back to an all-brick building.
 - 7.1.5 The hope is to break ground in May. With a projected 10-12 month construction project.
 - 7.1.6 Letters will be going out to parishioners and school parents about the building project.
 - 7.1.7 Father is hoping by the end of this week the resolution will be sent to the Bishop and things will be able to be locked in.
 - 7.2 Right now we are working with 3 modular companies.

- 7.2.1 There is a good chance that our 2nd second grade classroom would be held in this modular.
- 7.2.2 This would be placed along the fence in the parking lot
- 7.3 Bathroom project is slated to begin this summer on the remaining 5 bathrooms. Project cost is estimated around \$100,000.
- 7.4 A new principal has been hired as well as a new administrative assistant.
 - 7.4.1 5 people applied for the job and 3 of those candidates were interviewed.
 - 7.4.2 Narcel Clark has been hired as the principal. She is a veteran teacher in SD. She has taught on the reservation for 33 years. She is working on her administrative degree.
 - 7.4.3 An administrative assistant was hired out of Boise, ID. She is moving to Williston late spring, early summer. She also has a theology degree.
