- 1 Call to order and opening prayer
  - 1.1 In attendance: Father Kovash, Father Greg, Narcel Clark, Matt Kohler, Abbey Dahlberg, Brandon Johnson, Joan Zander
    Absent: Kelsey Lee, Jonathon Westphal
- 2 Previous Meeting Minutes
  - 2.1 November meeting minutes approved; motion by Matt Kohler, second by Joan Zander;
  - 2.2 December meeting minutes approved; motion by Brandon Johnson, second by Matt Kohler
- 3 Financial Report
  - 3.1 No Financial Report Given
- 4 Principal's Report given by Narcel Clark
  - 4.1 Enrollment is at 214
  - 4.2 We have had 4 snow days; we had enough built in so we won't have to make these up
  - 4.3 Didn't have December in-service due to snow day-Alice training was rescheduled to January
  - 4.4 In-service on January 16- IXL training; Alice training was canceled by the instructors-rescheduled for March; school and church staff discussed safety concerns
  - 4.5 Safety Assessment was done by ND Safety Council on January 4<sup>th</sup>. We received a 42-page report back, but haven't had an opportunity to go through it yet.
  - 4.6 Candy Sales have kicked off, ending Feb. 17
  - 4.7 Enrollment for existing families began on Jan. 17<sup>th</sup>

- 4.7.1 59 finished; 17 in process
- 4.8 Evaluations of Certified staff are finished
- 4.9 Second Quarter ended on Jan. 18th
- 4.10 STAR winter benchmark testing is finished for math and reading except for a couple who missed.
  - 4.10.1 We are very pleased with the gains made
- 4.11 We in the process of deciding on a curriculum for math and science.
- 4.12 We have been focusing on student behavior
  - 4.12.1 We have seen some improvements.
  - 4.12.2 There were a couple student suspensions in recent days
  - 4.12.3 Discussion on the email sent out in 6<sup>th</sup> grade, especially the inclusion of the Act of Contrition as a punishment
- 4.13 Chromebooks have arrived, and we are working on getting them set up before state testing
  - 4.13.1 Chromebooks are not supposed to be going home.
  - 4.13.2 There was discussion on blocking sites etc. on the Chromebooks.
- 4.14 We are still exploring a keyboarding class. A staff member is willing to teach it.
  - 4.14.1 We will try to figure out how to get some instruction for this year's sixth grade class
- 4.15 Mrs. Clark will be evaluating non-certified staff
- 4.16 Mardi Gras is coming up this weekend; staff have been encouraged to help out
- 4.17 Local spelling bee will be held Friday, Jan. 27
- 4.18 Catholic Schools Week is Jan. 29- Feb. 4.
- 4.19 Staff Christmas party is on Friday, Feb. 3.
- 4.20 Inservice on Friday, Feb. 17 will be on conscious discipline. Training will be all day and there will be no school

- 8 Pastor's Report Given by Father Kovash
  - 8.1 Need a new non-Catholic School Board Member
    - 8.1.1 Erin Vournas has resigned as she has transferred her daughter out of the school
    - 8.1.2 Fr. Kovash has names for potential candidates
  - 8.2 Early Childhood Center
    - 8.2.1 4.37 Million has been raised and we about \$300,000 short of having the building paid for.
    - 8.2.2 The ad for the director position is out with the goal of hiring by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - 8.3 The Race for Technology raised \$57,000, exceeding our goal of \$50,000.

    Combined with EANS grant money, we should have most of our technology upgrade paid for.
    - 8.3.1 A suggestion was made to share the results of the fundraiser with the students.
  - 8.4 The vision committee has not met recently as we focus on present issues.
  - 8.5 Some background was given on last week's safety concern
    - 8.5.1 A suggestion was made to obtain walkie-talkies for the modular as they do not have a phone.

- 8.5.2 In this discussion, an example was given from another school to emphasize the importance of alerting parents of student injuries, even if they do not seem like a big deal.
