General Information

St. Joseph's School offers educational instruction from preschool through sixth grade. Coordinated Dress is required for grades K-6. Tuition and coordinated clothing assistance is available for those who seek it.

Our families are invited to participate in their children's educational experience. To facilitate this, we have subscribed to a program called ParentsWeb, which is an online program used to inform parents of school events, menus, announcements, grades, and more.

St. Joseph's School has a very active Parent Teacher Organization. This provides numerous opportunities for parents to be involved in their child's education. Each family is required to fulfill a 25 service hour commitment.

All are welcome at St. Joseph's regardless of their denomination.
