- 1. Call to Order and Opening Prayer

- 3. Review of Financial Statements

- 4. Administrator's Report
  - 4.1. Enrollment is at 217 for the current school year and is currently sitting at 202 for next year.
  - 4.2. The school completed State testing.
  - 4.3. The school has decided on Inspire Science Curriculum for grades 3-6.
    - 4.3.1. There is a lot of science curriculum embedded in the Language arts curriculum that will be enough for the lower grades.
  - 4.4. The staff had a science of reading training.

- 4.4.1. In May there will be another zoom training for this. The staff will also have to complete about 20 hours of training over the course of the summer.
- 4.4.2. Mrs. Clark will be doing an admin training on science of reading next week.
- 4.5. Safe Environment training has been completed.
- 4.6.The private schools met and did a title review. Reports for the year were reviewed to make sure that everything was in compliance.
- 4.7. The school will be doing year end benchmarks soon. The lower grades have started, and they are looking good. The lower grades are all testing at grade level.
- 4.8. Next year there are only 15 students enrolled at this time (There are currently 21 Kindergartners).
  - 4.8.1. The decision has been made to only have 1 first grade classroom next year and Mrs. Kramer will move to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade which she is really excited about.
  - 4.8.2. There is a person who has interviewed for the 6<sup>th</sup> grade position and will be having a 2<sup>nd</sup> interview. He is a local teacher from the public school.
- 4.9. Next Year Shelby Treider has been hired as the new full-day preschool teacher and Ben Lee has been hired for a music and band teacher.

  - 5.1. The PTO is working on Teacher Appreciation Week.

- 7.1. The board discussed how to advertise our openings for the next school year.

- 8. Pastor's Report

  - 8.2. Ray Urbi is retiring. He is being replaced by Alex Kitchens. He started last Monday and Ray is training him in currently.
  - 8.3. Father Kovash and Mrs. Clark met with the public school district to claim the remaining IANS dollars amounting to about \$85,000.
  - 8.4.The board asked about how the structure of Catholic schools is typically run. Father Kovash stated that in the bigger towns they have a superintendent who is trained in education.
    - 8.4.1. Mandan, Standing Rock, and St. Joes (Williston) are the only ones who have a Priest as the super intendent.
  - 8.5. Little Joes Early Childhood Center
    - 8.5.1. A Director has been hired, Cheryl Mahnke, she owned and operated a childcare center in New York for 20 years with upwards of 150 kids. She has been teaching for the past 4 years.

8.5.1.1. She also has experience with grant writing and food service and such.
