  - 3.1 No Financial Report Given
- 4 Principal's Report given by Julie Quamme
  - 4.1 Enrollment
    - 4.1.1 Current enrollment for this year is at 210.
    - 4.1.2 Next year's enrollment is at 202 already enrolled and 21 in the process of enrolling.
  - 4.2 Curriculum
    - 4.2.1 Wonders 2023 (ELA) cost is \$53,000 58,000 for 6 years.
      - 4.2.1.1 A resolution has been sent to the Bishop and hopefully will be approved in 2 weeks.
      - 4.2.1.2 There will be a training in October and again in January.
    - 4.2.2 The Math curriculum that is currently being used is being discontinued and will need to be updated after the 2022-2023 school year.

  - 4.3.2 ELA 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade 53% (State avg is 39%); 4<sup>th</sup> Grade 29% (State avg is 42%); 5<sup>th</sup> Grade 65% (State avg is 46%); 6<sup>th</sup> Grade 60% (State avg is 49%)
  - 4.3.3 Math 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade 47% (State avg is 49%); 4<sup>th</sup> Grade 22% (State avg is 37%); 5<sup>th</sup> Grade 70% (State avg is 44%); 6<sup>th</sup> Grade 35% (State avg is 40%)

  - 6.1 School Board used to do Mass Intentions.
    - 6.1.1 The board picked two mass intentions and talked about resuming this tradition in the fall.
- 7 Pastors Report given by Father Kovash
  - 7.1 Word of Life new religion curriculum
    - 7.1.1 Gets parents involved on a very intentional basis.
    - 7.1.2 The Body Matters will be used as a supplemental curriculum. It is based off of Theology of the Body.
  - 7.2 Early Childhood Center
    - 7.2.1 Current fundraising is 3.712 million committed. Total cost is 4.35 million including furnishings.
    - 7.2.2 Groundbreaking is still scheduled for this month.
  - 7.3 The school is looking for a modular for the second 2<sup>nd</sup> grade classroom for next year.
    - 7.3.1 Cost of the modular is around \$33,000/year including desks. The modular is big enough for 20 kids.
